## Mission- (Home & Abroad)

#### CMSI – Bert Rea

**Kenya** – Please pray for the 4 million people who are currently facing hunger due to the worst drought in 40 years, with no rain at all for the last 4 rainy seasons. Many of the domestic animals essential for food and survival are dying eg cows, sheep and goats. Wild animals are also suffering. Many schools don't have food for school meals, so children have to sit through the day with only water to fill their stomachs, making it very difficult to study. Pray that God will send rain, and that sufficient food will be available to prevent starvation .Please also pray for the many aid agencies as they become involved in the crisis.

**COP27** has recently met in Egypt to discuss the ongoing climate emergency, with particular regard to the effect on areas such as food, agriculture, water, nature, oceans and human settlements. Please pray that all world leaders at COP27 will carry through on their promises.

Pray for the small team who are beginning to develop a partnership plan with CMSi.

#### Alpha- Jill Clayton

Please pray for the Alpha course starting at 6.30pm on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> January in St John's Church.
