Some Prayer Points From Revd Jonny

I am very conscious that in this past month we have seen so many people in our church family and community die. In the space of 7 days I conducted 5 funerals, Pray for each family that either has lost a loved one, or there is an anniversary approaching which brings grief very much to the forefront of their minds.

As I have just attended the 2 Boys' Brigade display nights, I give thanks to God for the incredible sense of God's presence in those boys. He is doing an incredible work in the lives of all our young people and the future for our community is bright when I look at their spiritual development. Keep praying for the families of all our young people, the they would be such a witness to their parents and siblings.

Give thanks to God for the powerful impact Alpha has been in sharing the message of Jesus with those seeking. We have been so blessed over the last 10 weeks and now that it has concluded I give thanks for the wonderful Godly leaders that have helped bring the message of the Gospel to our guests. Pray now for the planning that takes place for post-Alpha bible studies, that God would provide a leader to oversee this.

In St John's we are really keen to find someone to over see the music each week. Pray that God would direct the right person to support me in the oversight of Sunday worship.

Similarly we give thanks as the Choir in Christ Church have now returned to processing and recessing in Services post-COVID. Pray for new members to join the choir. Also pray for support for Andrew our organist when Jenny goes on maternity leave in May.

Pray that God would continue to sustain myself, Rachel Stewart & Emily Brannigan as we lead our youth team in preparation for the mission to Tarragona in Spain. Give thanks to God for an incredible bunch of teens we are taking to Spain, that God would mould and develop them into leaders for His service.

Pray for my own preparations as I visit our mission partners in Nairobi, Kenya in May - that God would equip me with His word as I begin to consider the teaching I will do whilst out there. Pray for all the practical arrangements that now need to be sorted - finances, vaccinations, programme planning.

Prayer Points From Revd Jonny

Continue to pray for my role as chaplain to Antrim Hospital; in each patient I meet they would know the comfort, strength & healing of God. I am also trying to complete a Post-graduate course in Chaplaincy and essays are now looming. Pray that God would equip me with the time I need to have these completed before I leave for Nairobi.

Pray for my role as Chair to the Church of Ireland Marriage Council that God would direct the Council's path to support couples in marriage across the island. Alison and I will lead for 6 weeks a Marriage Enrichment course across Ireland. Pray that couples would be enriched in their relationships through this course. Pray also for General Synod in May in which the Marriage Council will present a new video outlining our purpose and aims.

I thank God for our parish's commitment to be faithful to the proclamation of the Gospel. Pray that everyone who leads and preaches from both churches is led by the power of the Holy Spirit and that ears would hear afresh God's word.

Select Vestry

Give thanks to God for those who have served faithfully in this past year within the Select Vestry, including the wardens who welcome people into our churches each Sunday and support Jonny in preparations for Sunday worship
