Thursday: Youth & Children's Ministries

Church-led Groups that meet each week: Boys Brigade, Youth Fellowship, St John's creche, JAM, Lighthouse, Christ Church Sunday School and youth Bible study, Friday night discipleship group, Exodus Mission Team preparation.

- 9. For our young people that are at University, that they would connect with other Christians for encouragement, and find a church family to join.
- 9. For our BB company section who from January will be absorbing the boys from Ballynure company. Pray that the new boys would settle, and pray that eventually Ballynure would be able to grow again to restart.
