You may have seen new green and brown bins at St John's. The brown bin will take **garden & food waste only**. The green will take general, cardboard, bottles & glass & general waste. The Boys' Brigade recycle tins separately so these can be left bagged in the hall porch area.

In St John's we now have recycling bins in our hall, kitchen and lounge. They are labelled and used for items such as tins, plastic, glass, cardboard. One is clearly marked **FOOD WASTE ONLY**. After you have used the hall, if the food waste bin can be emptied and a new biodegradable liner bag inserted- these bags are kept in kitchen under the sink.
