Prayer Points from Revd Jonny

It is so encouraging to me to know that people are praying for the work of God's Kingdom in our churches and in our community. As Paul instructed the Church in Thessalonica - Rejoice always and pray without ceasing. I would encourage you to lift our parish before God daily.

I am very aware of the significant number of families who are challenged by illness or adjusting to life without a loved one. We are a family church, and therefore as people celebrate, we celebrate with them, and when people are mourning we mourn with them. Lift to God all those in our News Sheet prayer list who need the assurance of his presence in these days.

We are thankful for the training that has taken place on evangelism. In this year of evangelism, pray that God will direct us to the next steps. Pray that within your own context, amongst friends and family, you may witness of Christ's love to others. Pray that God would equip you to tell your story to others so they may know the hope that we carry with us daily.

I continue to have a heart to see the village of Ballynure awaken to the message of the Gospel. Pray that God will guide us on how we step forward to share the Gospel in the village.

Pray about the growing persecution happening in India and against the growing ideology, Hindutva, that seeks to make Hinduism dominant in India.
